The Good Shepherd represents faithfulness, diligence, tenderness, wisdom, as well as a willingness to lay down his life for the sheep.

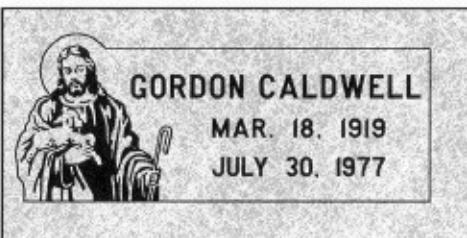

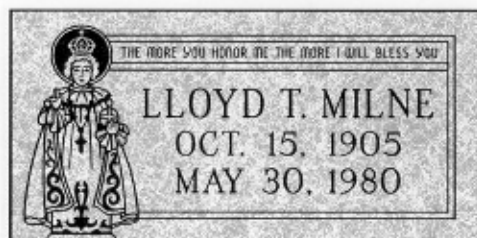

The Infant of Prague represents the Infant Jesus and the promise of mercy, peace, honor, and blessings.



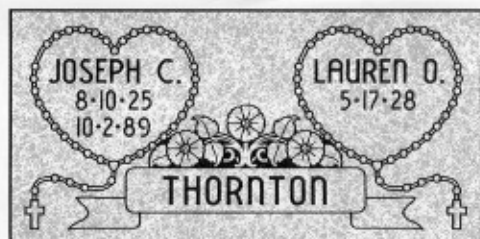

The history of the Church is abundant in symbolism. The many symbols of the faith include the Cross, the Sacred Heart, the Rosary as well as honored saints.



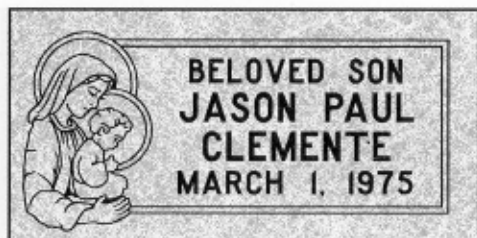
